It is with great pleasure and pride that I present this Annual Report to showcase our progress in terms of various activities & achievements made during the academic year 2022- 23.

A great saying goes so “Real education fetches you more than a job, it teaches you to live. It cannot be measured in every tangible way”.

Years back Poojya Gurudev had a vision where children were the focal point, a vision to transform our country through our children and to make them empowered in different areas. This vision is now fulfilled as we find our children scripting history at the national level.

Chinmaya Vidyalaya Taliparamba has grown from few classes to one of the biggest schools in the state with 60 classrooms and fully equipped laboratories. In its march of 35 years and striving for excellence there have been many pinnacles of success. At present we have classes from LKG to XII with a total strength of around 1300 students and 80 staff members.

### **Features:**

#### **1. Teaching faculty:**

Our School aspires to be an institution where all the members are trained to perform efficiently. The school is blessed as a team of teachers with all capabilities, highly dedicated and empathetic to the student needs, who upgrade their knowledge and teaching methodologies in accordance with the changing trends of education.

## **2. Safety and security:**

The safety and security of our students is our priority in school. In order to provide a secure environment for our student the school has installed 48 CCTV cameras around the school campus to ensure safety at all times.

## **3. Transport**

The best transport service is facilitated by our school for the convenience of its students. For supervision and monitoring a transport attendant is on board throughout the safe journey.

## **4. Laboratories**

We have well equipped separate laboratories for physics, chemistry and biology and computer science. These labs are renovated regularly for getting a firsthand learning experience by performing different experiments on their own.

## **5. Digital class rooms**

Digital class rooms are used as an educational collaborative device to facilitate classroom teaching and digital learning in our Vidyalaya.

## **6. Computer Lab**

The school has 2 well equipped computer labs separate for senior students and juniors supported by internet facility.

## **7. CBSE School Affiliation**

Our school got extension of its CBSE affiliation till 2027 March.

## **8. Remedial classes**

With “No student left behind” as our motto, we strived to bridge the learning gaps and bring each child to the relevant class level, remedial classes were conducted for students who need extra attention.

## **9. School Library**

The school library is a centre that provides a range of learning opportunities for students as well as teachers with a flair for reading and knowledge. Our school library has a large variety of

books, approximately 8000, ranging from frictions for primary students to classic of world literature. The books and journals have been arranged meticulously in different shelves.

## **10. PTA**

PTA was constituted to facilitate the active involvement of parents and teachers in the day to day activities of the school. Sri Anil Kumar served as its President and Smt Ambili Sooraj as Vice President. PTA meetings were held periodically.
